- Protecting long-term profitability
- Reducing financial and operational exposure
- Strengthening governance
- Building competitive advantage in a tightening regulatory and capital market landscape

Why this matters for your business

Climate, biodiversity loss and water stress is no longer a sustainability issue. It is a core financial issue.

- [82% of companies](#) are increasing sustainability investments, and nearly half report positive ROI. 75% see sustainability as central to future-proofing.

The strategic question is no longer *whether* to invest but how to align environmental investments with long-term value creation and corporate strategy. This program is designed to answer how environmental and climate action is a strategic driver of business value and long-term resilience.

The program

Time in nature is intentionally integrated as a leadership tool. Stepping outside the corporate environment strengthens perspective and honest peer dialogue. Over the 2,5 focused days you will experience the beautiful nature of the island and have time to enjoy the archipelago surroundings with kayaking, sauna and a cold swim, campfire conversations, and shared dinners.
